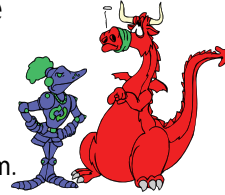

Gold in the Hills

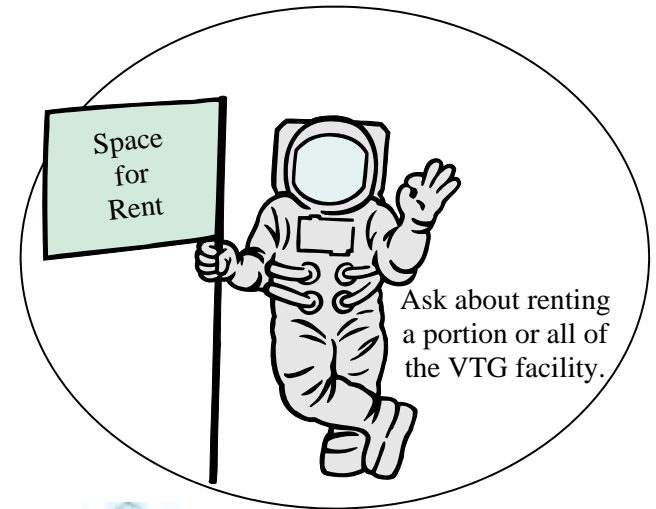
